LEARN TO SKATE DULUTH COVID-19 SAFETETY GUIDELINES

1. We will be asking that you as a family go through this daily health checklist before leaving for the rink: * Fever over 100 degrees, *Cough, *Shortness of breath, *Chills, *Muscle aches, *Sore throat, *New loss of taste or smell *Nausea

If the answer to any of these symptoms is yes, please do not send your skater to the rink. Please notify us asap if exposure has occurred.

- 2. All coaches will be wearing masks. All skaters are required to wear masks upon entry into the building & while participating in class.
- Skaters will be allowed into the building 10 minutes prior to the start of the class. Learn to Skate building entrance
 9:05am. No late entry. Doors will close at 9:15am. Skaters must immediately exit at the completion of class.
- 4. All skaters must come dressed and ready to participate.

 Skates must be on upon entering the building. **Hard guards are required.** (Guards are available at Play it Again, Stewart's, Amazon etc.)
- 5. Skaters should **NOT** bring any additional items in with them.
- 6. Parents and spectators will not be allowed into the facility in an effort to reduce exposure.
- 7. All skaters **MUST** sanitize their hands upon entering the building.
- 8. Skaters will sit in the bleachers on a marked MARS STICKER until the coach gathers them to enter the ice.
- 9. SKATERS WILL RECEIVE A GROUP NUMBER UPON ENTRACE FOR WHICH SECTION TO SIT IN.

- 10. Groups will be dismissed for the ice one at a time, to avoid any crossing of groups entering & exiting the ice surface. Skaters & Coaches will stay in their **SPECIFC** group area for the entirety of class.
- 11. There is a restroom available in emergency, however please try to take care of all bathroom needs prior to arriving or immediately upon entering the building.
- 12. Please note: Due to Covid-19 guidelines class sizes will be limited to 15 skaters.
- 13. Include the emergency contact number on your registration form & it is recommended that parents stay on the premises during classes (outside) in-case of emergency.
